The lessons are based on Scripture. This is a class who learn by lecture and group discussion.	

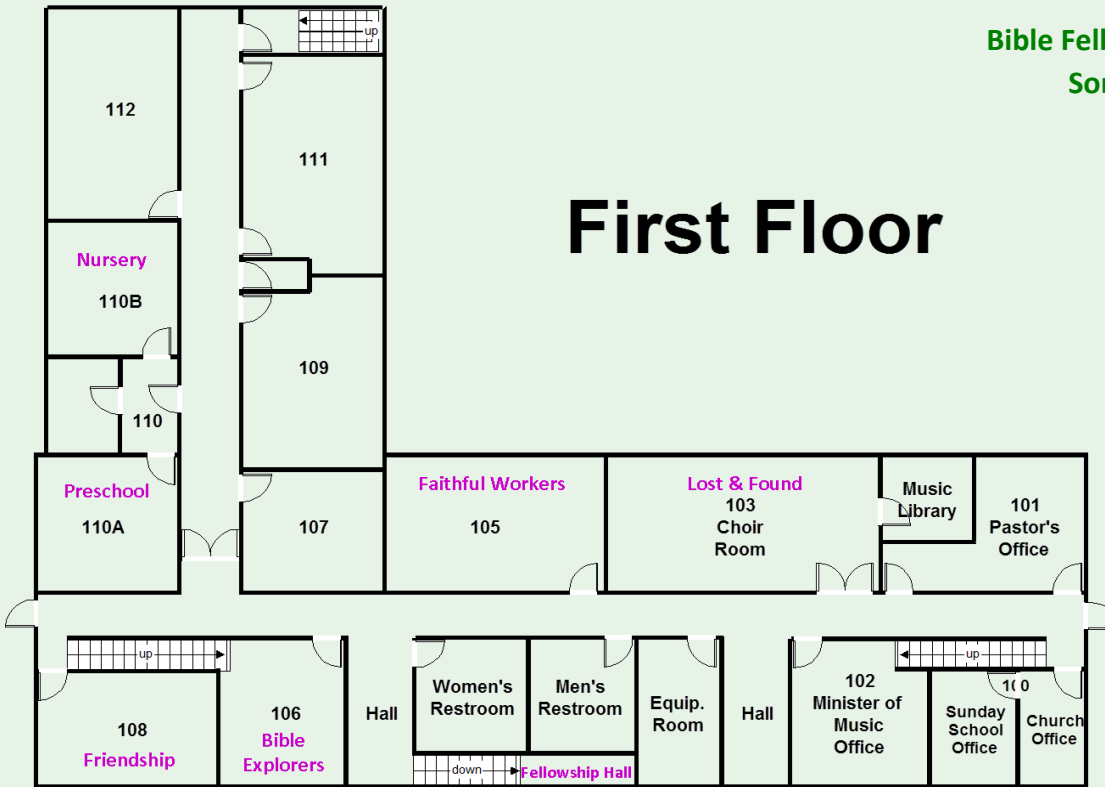
Lighthouse Keepers	Room 209
