

Youth Ministry Assistant Position

Position Description

- This part time position is a paid, hourly position to assist with the Youth Ministry program (6th-12th grade) at Ferry Farm Baptist Church. The purpose of this position will be to assist with planning and leading the weekly meetings of the Youth Ministry program.

Role and Responsibilities

- Develop and nurture relationships with Youth Ministry students and their families
- Actively lead and participate in service and discipleship activities for the youth
- Work in coordination with FFBC's pastoral and support staff
- Connect with students during Bible Fellowship (BF) on Sunday mornings
- Plan and lead activities on Wednesday and Sunday evenings, with support from youth lay leaders.
- Create programs inclusive of all youth of the church
- Grow, train and disciple youth leaders by creating pathways for lay leaders to serve.
- Identify opportunities and engage students in missions and outreach ministries
- Plan/coordinate and lead activities to promote community among the students (i.e., retreat, outings, VBS, etc.)
- Create an environment in which all youth can actively grow in their faith
